PICK 5 GAME

PLAY DIRECTIVE

Issued: 8/1/21

This directive is designed to provide a guideline for the conduct of an on-line game to be designated "Pick 5". In the event of conflict between the provisions of this and any other directive or other publication of the Corporation concerning the conduct of the Pick 5 game, the provisions of this directive shall govern.

Definitions

Lottery or Louisiana Lottery -

The lottery or lotteries established and operated pursuant to the Louisiana Lottery Corporation Law.

- Corporation -

The Louisiana Lottery Corporation.

- President -

President of the Louisiana Lottery Corporation, or any other person to whom the President's authority is lawfully delegated.

Official Lottery Retailer -

A Louisiana retailer who has entered into a licensing agreement with the Corporation whereby the retailer is authorized to sell Lottery game tickets.

Pick 5 Game Ticket -

An official ticket for the Pick 5 game, issued by the Corporation, produced by an Official Lottery retailer in an authorized manner, bearing player or computer selected numbers, figures and/or characters representing the type of wager, drawing date, amount of wager, and validation data.

- Authorized Claim Center -

Any Official Lottery retailer, Corporation Regional Office or Corporation Headquarters.

- Quick-Pick -

A player option by which Pick 5 number selections are determined, at random, by computer software.

Pick 5 -

A game in which five (5) single-digit numbers, one from each of five separate sets numbered zero (0) through nine (9), are randomly selected at each Pick 5 drawing, which selection process shall determine the winning Pick 5 plays for each such drawing.

Pick 5 Game Panel –

That area of an official Pick 5 game ticket identified by a two, three, four or five-digit player or computer selected number, reflected on the Corporation's computer records.

Pick 5 Bet Slip (or "playslip") -

A machine readable, official form issued by the Lottery through its retailer network, used in purchasing an official Pick 5 game ticket.

Lottery Official Mobile App -

An official application developed and administered by the Lottery

Ticket Sales

The sale of official Pick 5 game tickets may be conducted only by such retailers as the President shall license pursuant to Corporation regulations, rules, policies and directives for Official Lottery retailer licensing.

Ticket Price

Official Pick 5 game tickets may be purchased at the base price of \$.50 or \$1.00 for a one panel, one play, one draw, 2, 3, 4 or 5 digit number, dependent on wager type. Any wager may be purchased in multiple plays and multiple draws, in accordance with system parameters.

The President may authorize the sale of any official Pick 5 ticket at a discount for promotional purposes. The President may also authorize the production and distribution of tickets at no cost to the recipients, for promotional purposes.

Play Characteristics and Restrictions

Pick 5 tickets may only be sold to persons 21 years of age or older, who are not otherwise specifically disqualified as players or prize recipients by statute or Corporation regulation, policy, rule or directive.

An official Pick 5 ticket shall be the only valid proof of the wager placed, and the only valid receipt for claiming or redeeming any prize.

Official Pick 5 tickets may be canceled on the calendar day purchased at the same retailer terminal from which the ticket was issued. If the ticket is purchased before the 9:30 p.m. drawbreak, it may only be canceled prior to the 9:30 p.m. drawbreak. Tickets purchased after the 9:30 p.m. drawbreak must be canceled before 12:00 midnight the same calendar day.

A purchaser may submit a completed Pick 5 bet slip to an Official Lottery retailer when

requesting an official Pick 5 game ticket. Pick 5 bet slips shall be available at no cost to the player, and shall have no pecuniary or prize value, nor shall such bet slips constitute evidence of purchase of tickets or of particular number selections.

A purchaser may submit a Pick 5 bet slip completed on the Lottery Official Mobile App to an Official Lottery retailer when requesting an official Pick 5 game ticket.

A player may orally convey his or her number selections to an Official Lottery retailer when requesting an official Pick 5 ticket, and such selections may be manually entered into the computer terminal by the retailer, or the player may request a computer-generated random number selection.

It shall be the sole responsibility of the ticket purchaser to verify the accuracy and condition of the data printed on the official Pick 5 ticket at the time of purchase.

Official Pick 5 game tickets may, at the player's discretion, be purchased for one (1) through seven (7) consecutive drawings or one (1) through fourteen (14) consecutive drawings commencing with the next scheduled drawing. Tickets may also be purchased for future drawings within the next seven (7) days of the next scheduled drawing, in accordance with system parameters.

Time, Place and Manner of Conducting Drawings

Pick 5 drawings shall be conducted at such times and locations as may be determined by the President, and shall be publicly announced by the Corporation.

The objective of Pick 5 drawings shall be to select, at random, with the aid of computerized or mechanical drawing equipment, winning numbers, pursuant to the controls and methods specified by the Corporation.

Prize Payouts and Odds

The prize payment structure and probabilities of winning (probabilities being expressed as "odds" of winning, as that term is applied in common usage in the lottery industry) are as specified on Schedule "A" to this Directive.

The winnings pool consists of approximately 50% of net Pick 5 sales. Winnings pool excess prize money shall be allocated to a daily numbers games prize reserve pool. Winnings pool shortfalls may be funded from the daily numbers games prize reserve pool or any other reserve funds made available at the discretion of the President.

Prize Liability Limit

The Corporation may from time to time establish a prize liability limit for sales of tickets for any given drawing without public notice, thereby restricting sales of tickets for such drawing if the liability limit would be exceeded by the drawing of any particular numbers.

Interest

No interest shall be paid with respect to any Pick 5 prize claim.

<u>Ticket Responsibility</u>

An official Pick 5 winning ticket is deemed to be owned by the person, partnership or association named on the ticket or, in the case of a ticket not completed with name and address, by the ticket bearer.

The Corporation shall not be responsible for lost or stolen official Pick 5 tickets.

The purchaser of an official Pick 5 ticket has the sole responsibility for verifying the accuracy and condition of the data printed on the ticket at the time of purchase.

The Corporation shall **not** be responsible to the player for Official Lottery retailer errors in redemption or Official Lottery retailer representations as to the validity or status of a ticket.

Ticket Validation Requirements

In order to be deemed a valid official Pick 5 winning ticket, all of the following conditions must be met:

- (a) The validation data must be present in its entirety and the play number selection printed on the ticket and the corresponding drawing date(s) printed on the ticket, must correspond with the data reflected in the Corporation's computer records relating to production of the ticket. The ticket must have been produced prior to the drawing;
- (b) the ticket must be intact;
- (c) the ticket must not be mutilated, altered, reconstituted, or tampered with in any manner;
- (d) the ticket must neither be counterfeit nor an exact duplicate of another winning ticket;

- (e) the ticket must have been issued by an Official Lottery retailer in an authorized manner on official paper stock;
- (f) the ticket must not have been stolen or canceled;
- (g) the ticket must be submitted for payment in accordance with the provisions of "Procedures For Claiming and Payment of Prizes", hereinafter set forth;
- (h) the ticket data must have been recorded on the central computer system prior to the drawing, and the ticket data must match the computer record data in every respect;
- (i) the player or computer number selections, validation data and drawing date(s) of an apparent winning ticket must appear on the Corporation's computer records and a ticket with that exact data must not have been previously paid;
- (j) the ticket must not be misregistered, defectively printed, or printed or produced in error to an extent that it cannot be validated by the Corporation;
- (k) the ticket must pass all other confidential security checks of the Corporation;
- (l) in submitting an official Pick 5 ticket for validation, the player agrees to abide by applicable laws, all Corporation rules, regulations, policies, directives, instructions, conditions and final decisions of the President of the Corporation.

A Pick 5 ticket submitted for validation which fails any of the preceding validation conditions shall be considered void. In the event a defective ticket, or a ticket of disputed validity is presented for payment, the President may, at his or her sole discretion, elect to replace such a ticket with a ticket or tickets of equivalent sales price from any current lottery game, and such replacement shall be the sole and exclusive remedy of the player with respect to any claim arising with respect to such a ticket.

Procedure For Claiming and Payment of Prizes

Holders of winning tickets for prizes up to and including \$50.00 may claim their prizes at any Official Lottery retailer location. Prizes of \$51.00 up to and including \$600.00 may be redeemed at Official Lottery retailer locations, subject to the discretion of the retailer. Holders of winning tickets for prizes for any amount may claim their prizes at the Corporation's Regional Offices or Headquarters.

A Pick 5 prize must be claimed within one hundred eighty (180) days after the drawing in which the prize was won. In the event that a single official Pick 5 ticket contains a winning game panel for two or more winning games, if the cumulative prize amount does not exceed \$600.00, the ticket may be claimed through an Official Lottery retailer. If the cumulative prize amount exceeds

\$600.00, the ticket must be presented to the Corporation for payment.

The payment of prizes to persons under 21 years of age, and payments made with respect to persons who may die before receiving any or all of a particular prize shall be paid in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 57:9025. The Corporation shall be discharged of any and all liability after payment of prizes as provided by said statutory provision.

Louisiana and federal income taxes shall be withheld by the Corporation for prize payments in such amounts as may be required in accordance with applicable provisions of federal and state law.

Pick 5 prizes shall not be paid to any of the following persons:

- (a) To any assignee of the right to receive a prize, or any portion thereof;
- (b) any member of the Board of Directors, officer, or employee of the Corporation or to any spouse, child, brother, sister, or parent residing as a member of the same household in the principle place of abode of any such person;
- (c) any member of the Board of Directors, officer, or employee assigned to perform services for the Corporation (including corporate software services) of an on-line computer systems vendor under contract with the Corporation, or to any spouse, child, brother, sister, or parent residing as a member of the same household in the principle place of abode of any such person;
- (d) any member of the Board of Directors, officer, or employee assigned to perform services for the Corporation (including corporate software services) of a vendor under sub-contract with the on-line computer systems vendor under contract with the Corporation, or to any spouse, child, brother, sister, or parent residing as a member of the same household in the principle place of abode of any such person;
- (e) those employees of audit firms or entities actually performing on-site contractual audit services with respect to the Corporation's operations;
- (f) employees of any vendor of goods or services to the Corporation barred from game play or prize payment by contractual provision, or as a result of a written determination by the President of the Corporation that game play participation by such vendor, or certain of its employees, may jeopardize the security and integrity of lottery gaming;
- (g) any employees of any advertising agency, public relations agency, or gaming consultant currently under contract with the Corporation and engaged in activities in direct support of the Corporation's advertising and promotional functions, as account managers or representatives.

Unclaimed Prize Money

Prize monies allocated for the payment of Pick 5 winning tickets shall be retained by the Corporation for payment to the ticket holder or holders entitled thereto. Any prize monies remaining unclaimed at the conclusion of the statutory claim period shall be added to the unclaimed prize funds for future prize award, as provided by law.

Governing Law

In purchasing a ticket, the purchaser agrees to comply with, and abide by, Louisiana State Law and all rules, regulations, policies, directives and final decisions of the lottery, and all procedures established by the President for the conduct of the game.

Effective Date

This Pick 5 Game Play Directive shall become effective at 12:00 a.m., Sunday, August 1, 2021.

Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of the information provided in this directive. However, in the event of an error, the directive in the official files of the Louisiana Lottery shall be controlling.

Addendum to Game Play Directive

Governor Edwards issued Proclamation Number 33 JBE 2020, the provisions of which were effective from 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2020 to Monday, April 13, 2020. With Proclamation Number 51 JBE 2020, Governor Edwards extended Proclamation Number 33 JBE 2020 until 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 30, 2020. On April 27, 2020, Governor Edwards announced that he would extend his Stay at Home Order until Friday, May 15, 2020. The proclamation directed all state office buildings to be closed to the public. Accordingly, the Louisiana Lottery Corporation Headquarters and Regional Offices will be closed to the public during this time period.

These closures will result in players being unable to present prize claims for payment.

Instant and Online Game Directives provide for the payment of prizes to the holder of a winning ticket. Due to the extended period of office closures, I have determined that a mailed in copy of the front and back of a winning ticket meeting all of the remaining qualifications for a valid prize will serve as submission of an official winning ticket for the payment of a prize claim for prizes \$5,000 and below for all games with the exception of Powerball and Mega Millions. This process will remain in effect until the Louisiana Lottery Corporation's claim centers are fully functional.

For those claims greater than \$5,000 and for Powerball and Mega Millions winning tickets, please contact the Louisiana Lottery at prizepayments@louisianalottery.com to set up an appointment to claim your prizes.

The claims process as amended is as follow:

Player must provide

- A clear copy of the front and back of the winning ticket.
- All scratch off material must be removed from the instant game tickets before copies are made.
- The signature of the claimant must appear on the back of the ticket.
- A completed claim form with a contact phone number provided to answer any questions regarding the claim.
- A copy of a current picture identification containing the claimant's name (for example, a driver's license).
- Please do not include the original winning ticket.

If there are any questions regarding the validity of the winning ticket, the original ticket may be required to validate and pay the prize.

Upon validation of the winning ticket, a prize check will be issued to the claimant listed on the claim form and mailed to the address listed on the claim form.
