DRAWING DIRECTIVE

Amendment #1 – June 2026

Overview

This directive is designed to provide a guideline for the conduct of the Louisiana Lottery Powerball Second-Chance Drawings in a fair and secure manner. An attempt has been made to provide for all contingencies, but should special situations arise once the promotion begins and the drawings actually occur, this document will be amended as necessary.

Drawing Dates & Prizes

The Louisiana Lottery Corporation will conduct two (2) Powerball Second-Chance Drawings to select one (1) NASCAR Powerball – The Chase Louisiana Semifinalist winner, ten (10) \$500 prize winners and one (1) \$10,000 prize winner as set forth in the **Louisiana Lottery Powerball Scratch-Off Game Directive**. Each winner in both drawings will also receive a Louisiana Lottery Prize Package. The Louisiana Lottery drawings will be conducted and prizes awarded as follows:

** The second and final drawing will be conducted after the closure of the Powerball® scratch-off game or as announced by the President.*

The odds of being selected in the Louisiana Lottery Powerball Second Chance Drawing will depend on the number of entries received for each drawing.

The Louisiana Lottery Prize Package includes: one (1) Louisiana Lottery branded auto shade, two (2) Powerball cups, one (1) Louisiana Thing crawfish tray, two (2) Louisiana Lottery 35th Anniversary branded car fresheners, three (3) Powerball/Louisiana Lottery branded t-shirts, one

(1) Powerball water bottle, two (2) Louisiana Lottery branded koozies, and one (1) Louisiana Lottery branded trunk organizer.

Each NASCAR Powerball – The Chase Louisiana Semifinalist will be entered into a national drawing with other participating lotteries to participate in a series of drawings that culminate in a \$1 million prize broadcast live from Homestead-Miami Speedway® during the NASCAR Cup Series Championship™ Race on Nov. 8, 2026. Cash prizes will be awarded to all National Semifinalists based on their position in The Chase and set forth below in “National Drawing Rounds”. Four (4) Finalists will receive a four-day/three-night VIP NASCAR Trip experience prize for themselves and one (1) guest to the NASCAR Championship Weekend™ Nov. 6-9, 2026. For a full description of the VIP NASCAR Trip Prize, see Exhibit A. Winners of the VIP NASCAR Trip shall not be required to travel to Miami, FL to participate in the drawing for, and to remain eligible to win, the \$1,000,000 Prize or other cash prizes. Winner may appoint a proxy to take the trip instead, subject to the Trip Prize Terms and Conditions, Exhibit B. Cash prizes awarded in National Elimination Round Drawings are subject to Federal/State Withholdings.

Valid Entries

A valid entry is at least \$10 worth of non-winning Louisiana Lottery Powerball® scratch-off tickets (game #1662) or one (1) \$10 non-winning 5-board Louisiana Lottery Powerball® single draw ticket purchased beginning March 2, 2026 submitted in accordance with Louisiana Lottery rules, regulations, procedures and State Law, and received by the entry deadline.

In the event an envelope contains a winning ticket/play, and the remaining eligible non-winning plays is reduced to less than the required minimum of five (5) boards, that entry will be deemed invalid and therefore disqualified.

Entries must be received by the Entry Deadline to be eligible for each drawing. Entries received for the first drawing but not drawn will be held over to be included in Drawing 2. Entries received after the deadline for Drawing 2 shall be deemed ineligible for the drawing and will be destroyed.

Players may enter multiple times, but each entry must be mailed separately. Entrants may only win one (1) prize per drawing. Entrants must be a Louisiana resident at least 21 years of age.

Only envelopes mailed to *Powerball 2nd Chance Drawing*, P.O. Box 92006, Baton Rouge, LA 70892, will be considered valid for participation in the drawing. No entries will be accepted at Louisiana Lottery Corporation offices, by retailers, or in regular mail. If any misdirected entry is received at a Lottery or retailer location, the recipient shall document the circumstances of his or her receipt of the purported entry and forward the documentation and entry to the Drawing Coordinator for review, determination of ineligibility, and ultimate destruction.

Envelopes received should be no larger than 4.5" x 9.5" and should have no unusual markings on the outside. Oversized envelopes or those not conforming to specifications will be rejected and destroyed unopened.

All mail becomes the property of the Louisiana Lottery Corporation.

Mailing of an envelope as an entry in the Louisiana Lottery Powerball Second Chance Drawing forfeits every right of ownership in each ticket contained in the envelope, whether the ticket is a winning or non-winning ticket, except the right to qualify as an entry in the Louisiana Lottery Powerball Second Chance Drawing. The Lottery is under no obligation to locate or allow access to any person to search for any envelope or ticket.

The Lottery will not accept any responsibility for mail received at the Louisiana Lottery Powerball Second Chance Drawing Post Office box that is not intended to be considered for participation in the drawing. For example, a prize claim mailed unintentionally to the Louisiana Lottery Powerball Second Chance Drawing Post Office box or mail otherwise not intended to be included in the drawing will be considered lost. The Lottery will make no attempt to locate such misdirected mail and will make no attempt to search for such items before the drawings or the ultimate destruction of the envelopes. Should a valid cash prize claim mistakenly mailed to the Louisiana Lottery Powerball Second Chance Drawing Post Office box be discovered in the ordinary course of the drawing process and the remaining eligible non-winning plays is reduced to less than the required minimum of five (5) boards, the claim and envelope will be treated as disqualified for drawing entry purposes and will be further processed on its merits as a cash prize claim.

Transportation of Envelopes

Drawing Officials and/or Mail Room personnel shall have the responsibility for picking up and transporting envelopes from the Post Office.

The envelopes will ultimately be stored at the Distribution Center which features a dual-key access locking system, requiring joint participation of the Drawing Official and a Lottery Security Officer.

Prior to storing the envelopes at the Distribution Center, the envelopes shall be transferred to mailbags or a secure container and will be sealed by the Drawing Official or designee. Each mailbag or secure container will be labeled "Powerball 2nd Chance Drawing". The number of mailbags received will be recorded on a form and dated and initialed by the Drawing Official and Security Officer. The seals will remain intact until removed, in the presence of an external auditor, hereinafter designated "Auditor", during the course of the drawing process.

Drawing Officials

The Drawing Coordinator, or his or her authorized designee, shall serve as the Drawing Official, and shall be responsible for the conduct of the drawing in accordance with this directive. The drawing shall be witnessed by a member of the Legislative Auditor's staff. The Drawing Official and the Auditor will monitor and record the results of the drawing. The Drawing Official will have the responsibility of validating the tickets selected, recording and distributing winner information to the appropriate parties, and providing a report of the drawing. The drawing report must be signed by both the Drawing Official and the Auditor and shall note any unusual occurrences or variations from the procedures outlined herein, and shall include the names and initials of any other official witness or participant in the drawing.

Pre-Drawing Procedures

The entry deadline and the schedule for the drawing is outlined on Page 2 of this directive or will be announced by the President. Prior to the drawing, the Drawing Official shall arrange all of the mailbags in which the envelopes are contained for the selection process. The Drawing Official and the Auditor shall record the total number of mailbags received for the drawing and shall make an estimate of the total volume of entry envelopes received and eligible for the drawing.

Drawings 1 and 2

In the presence of the Drawing Official and Auditor, the Louisiana Lottery Powerball Second Chance Drawing shall be conducted in two components: the first, a mailbag selection process and second, the winner selection component.

The drawing process will commence with the selection of three (3) mailbags containing envelopes with non-winning entry tickets from the Louisiana Lottery Powerball Second Chance Promotion. The mailbag selection process will be conducted on the announced day of the drawing. Each mailbag received by the entry deadline will be eligible for the drawing to be held that day. If the entries received by the deadline are contained in three (3) or less mailbags, the mailbag selection process will not be held and all three (3) mailbags shall be entered into the winner selection process.

The first stage of the drawing process will begin with the sequential numbering of each mailbag containing the non-winning entry envelopes. Separate envelopes will be prepared, each containing a number corresponding to a numbered mailbag. Each sealed envelope will be deposited into a small drum. The drum shall be rotated at least five times to provide a thorough mix of envelopes. The Drawing Coordinator or designee will then draw three envelopes one at a time. The mailbags corresponding to the number in each envelope shall be entered into the winner selection process. During this process for Drawing 1, the remaining bags will be secured and held over for Drawing 2.

Any mail received after the entry deadline for Drawing 1 will be eligible for the next drawing. Any mail received after the entry deadline for Drawing 2 will be destroyed.

The winner(s) selection component of the drawing shall be held as soon as possible after the selection of the mailbags and will also be held at the Lottery Distribution Center.

Drawing Procedures

The seals on the selected mailbags will be checked by the Auditor. Upon verification, the contents of the mailbags will be emptied into a large container and the container will be mixed to ensure an adequate mixing of the envelopes.

For Drawings 1 and 2, the Drawing Official or designee shall make the random selection of fifteen (15) envelopes from the container. He or she shall draw the envelopes, and each will be numbered accordingly (envelopes #1 through #15). The container should be rotated intermittently throughout the envelope selection to ensure an adequate mix of the envelopes. Each envelope will be sequentially numbered before another envelope is selected. The

procedure will be repeated until fifteen (15) envelopes have been selected from the drawing container.

The selection process will proceed with the opening and validation of the envelopes drawn, in the order drawn, commencing with the first such envelope selected. Commencing with the first envelope, the Drawing Official will then determine if the envelope meets the specifications required and will open the envelope to determine that it contains a valid entry. A valid entry consists of one (1) envelope with at least at least \$10 worth of non-winning Louisiana Lottery Powerball® scratch-off tickets (game #1662) or one (1) \$10 non-winning 5-board Louisiana Lottery Powerball® single draw ticket purchased beginning March 2, 2026. Eligibility is also subject to game play directives issued by the Lottery.

Entry Qualification for Drawings

The following guidelines should be considered by the Drawing Official and Auditor in the determination of whether an entry envelope selected in the procedure outlined above is eligible for further consideration, once the validity of the entry is established.

1. Legibility

The name, address, email and phone number of the ticket holder is written or printed, in legible form, on the back of the ticket in the envelope, or can be found, in part, in legible form on the envelope. The Drawing Official must determine whether the information provided is sufficiently legible to determine the identity of the ticket holder. In addition to being legible, if the address is not a Louisiana address, the entry shall be disqualified.

1. Completeness

If the required information is not included on the ticket or the envelope, or a combination thereof, the Drawing Official and Auditor must determine whether there is sufficient information available to identify and contact the ticket holder. If the determination is made that insufficient information is available to identify the ticket holder, the entry will be disqualified, and the selection process will proceed to the next envelope in the drawing sequence. In the event that information is included on the envelope, rather than on the ticket, the Drawing Official may accept the information thus provided. However, if the name on the envelope is different than the name on the ticket, only the information provided on the ticket will be considered.

2. Multiple Names

In the event that the ticket contains the names of more than one person, i.e. "John and Mary Smith", only the first listed name will be considered. In the example cited, the winner would be John Smith. Only one entry or individual's entries may be a winner. If the names of more than one person appear, individually, on separate entry tickets in an envelope, the entry shall be disqualified.

3. Clubs/Groups

A group, club, organization or other entity may be an eligible winner, i.e., "ACME Corporation, Office Pool". Such an entry will be required to produce a Federal Employer's Identification Number (FEIN) before receiving any prize. One individual must be identified on the ticket as the representative of the group or entity and that person must be an officer or official of the entity. A non-profit entity is eligible to participate, but must provide proof of its non-profit status for purposes of applicable withholding requirements.

4. Multiple Winners

While it is highly unlikely, it is possible that the same individual might be drawn twice in the drawing. Should this occur, the second envelope will be disqualified.

Determination of Winners

Drawing 1: The first envelope verified to meet all the qualifications will win the one NASCAR Powerball - The Chase Louisiana Semifinalist Prize Package. The next **FIVE (A#1)** (5) envelopes verified to meet all the qualifications will each win 500 dollars and a Louisiana Prize Package. The next nine (9) envelopes verified will be designated as alternates. In the event that less than nine (9) envelopes are designated as Alternate entries, the Drawing Official or designee may draw additional entries as needed to meet the minimum requirements, subject to Drawing Procedures outlined above.

Drawing 2: The first envelope verified to meet all the qualifications will win 10,000 dollars and a Louisiana Prize Package. The next **FIVE (A#1)** (5) envelopes verified to meet all the qualifications will each win 500 dollars and a Louisiana Prize Package. The next nine (9) envelopes verified will be designated as alternates. In the event that less than nine (9) envelopes are designated as Alternate entries, the Drawing Official or designee may draw additional entries as needed to meet the minimum requirements, subject to Drawing Procedures outlined above.

Post-Drawing

Drawing 1: Once fifteen (15) entries have been verified, the envelopes remaining in the drawing bin shall be transferred to the previous mailbags or secure containers and will be sealed by the Drawing Official or designee. Each mailbag or secure container will be labeled “Powerball 2nd Chance Drawing”.

Drawing 2: Once fifteen (15) entries have been verified, the envelopes remaining in the drawing bin shall be transferred to the previous mailbags or secure containers and will be marked for destruction.

Winner Notification

Drawing 1: The apparent NASCAR Powerball - The Chase Louisiana Semifinalist will be notified by mail/phone and a Winner Claim Form and Exhibit B: Trip Prize Terms and Conditions will be sent to the winner within two (2) business days of the second-chance drawing. A valid photo ID verifying age and residency will be requested. The winner must return the completed Winner Claim Form, written acknowledgement of Exhibit B: Trip Prize Terms and Conditions, and required documentation to the Lottery within seven (7) business days of receipt of notification or their prize will be reassigned to the next eligible entry drawn.

Once the Louisiana Semifinalist is verified, a Winner Claim Form will be sent to the \$500 prize winners. The winners must return the completed Winner Claim Form and required documentation to the Lottery within seven (7) business days of receipt of notification or their prize will be reassigned to the next eligible alternate.

The name of the verified NASCAR Powerball – The Chase Louisiana Semifinalist will be submitted by August 19, 2026 to the Multistate Lottery Association to participate in a series of drawings that culminate in a \$1 million prize broadcast live from Homestead-Miami Speedway® during the NASCAR Cup Series Championship™ Race on Nov. 8, 2026.

Drawing 2: A Winner Claim Form will be sent to the \$10,000 prize winner within five (5) business days of the Second Chance Drawing. The \$10,000 winner must return the completed Winner Claim Form and any required documentation to the Lottery within ten (10) business days of receipt of notification or their prize will be reassigned to the next eligible entry drawn. Once the \$10,000 prize winner is confirmed eligible, a Winner Claim Form will be sent to the \$500 prize winners. The winners must return the completed Winner Claim Form and any required documentation to the Lottery within ten (10) business days of receipt of notification or their prize will be reassigned to the next eligible alternate.

Winner Disqualification

It is possible after validation of an entry and qualification of a winner that it may be determined that the individual selected is not actually eligible to win a Lottery prize. For example, the winner may be determined to be a relative of a Lottery employee or otherwise disqualified by law or Lottery Rules to participate in the drawing process. Should this occur, the prize will be reassigned to the next eligible alternate.

Envelope Destruction

After Drawing 2, pending destruction of the remaining envelopes not selected in the drawing process, the mailbags will be marked to ensure that the envelopes contained therein are destroyed. As soon as is practicable after the drawing, the non-winning tickets will be destroyed in a manner set forth by the Louisiana Lottery Corporation.

Drawing Report

Within 48 hours after the drawing, the Drawing Officer must submit a report to the president on a prescribed form that notes the observance of all procedures, any variations from the procedures, and includes the names and initials of all official drawing participants and witnesses.

NASCAR POWERBALL THE CHASE™ PROMOTION (2026)

TRIP PRIZE DESCRIPTION

The Trip Prize consists of a four-day, three-night VIP trip for the entry selected from a pool of Participating Lotteries' entrants (each a Finalist or collectively "Finalists") and one (1) guest to Miami, FL, from approximately Friday, November 6, 2026 to Monday, November 9, 2026, to participate in a drawing for a prize in the amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) ("\$1 Million Prize") to be conducted Sunday, November 8, 2026 during the live television broadcast of the *NASCAR Cup Series Championship™ Race* on NBC ("Program") from Homestead-Miami Speedway, Homestead, FL. The Trip Prize approximate value is \$10,000 and may include the following or like elements:

- Round-trip, coach-class airline transportation for two (2) people from the major airport nearest Finalist's city to Miami, FL (if within 250 miles of Miami, FL, rail or ground transportation to be substituted);
- Three (3) nights hotel accommodations (selected by Prize Provider (Multi-State Lottery Association or its designee) in its sole discretion) in Florida (double occupancy, room and tax only);
- Two (2) Ally Pit Box at Homestead passes (includes food, beverages and Infield Experience access) at Homestead-Miami Speedway for admission to:
 - NASCAR O'Reilly Auto Parts Series Championship™ Race on Saturday, November 7, 2026
 - NASCAR Cup Series Championship Race™ on Sunday, November 8, 2026
- Two (2) passes for VIP Experiences at Homestead-Miami Speedway during NASCAR Championship Weekend™ for Saturday, November 7 and Sunday, November 8, 2026 including:
 - NASCAR Cup Series™ garage pass
 - NASCAR team hauler tour
 - MRN Radio booth tour
 - Pace car rides
 - Pre-Race attendance
 - Victory Lane access
- Two (2) Official NASCAR Championship Weekend™ Event Programs;
- Two (2) Souvenir Gift Bags, each with a retail value of at least two hundred fifty dollars (\$250);
- All meals while in Florida
- Ground transportation to and from airports, hotel, and activities in Florida

Finalists are not required to travel to Florida to participate in the drawing for, and remain eligible to win, the \$1 Million Prize. Finalists may appoint a proxy and provide contact information for the proxy, **on or before October 22, 2026** to take the trip instead, subject to the Trip Prize Terms and Conditions, but will still remain eligible to win the \$1 Million Prize.

- Finalist (or their proxy) may also have the opportunity to participate in the recording and production of the Program and/or appear in the broadcast of the Program, provided that Finalist completes and signs all required releases and forms and consents to a background check. If Finalist appoints a proxy, the proxy must complete and sign all required releases and clear the background check in order to take the trip. In the event that Finalist's designated proxy does not clear the background check, Prize Provider reserves the right, in its sole discretion, either to (i) allow Finalist to appoint another proxy to take the trip (subject to background clearance and Prize Provider

deadlines); or (ii) allow proxy to travel and to appoint a second proxy (selected by Prize Provider) to participate in the Program.

- For the avoidance of doubt, Finalist's eligibility to participate in the trip and/or the drawing for the \$1 Million Prize is not affected by Finalist's failure to complete and sign all required release and forms and/or to consent to a background check and/or by any information obtained pursuant to a background check, but those failures may affect the nature of his/her appearance and/or degree of participation in the Program. While Finalist's eligibility to participate in the drawing for the \$1 Million Prize is an element of the Trip Prize, the opportunity to participate in the recording and production of the Program and/or appear in the broadcast of the Program is expressly NOT an element of the Trip Prize and is determined by Prize Provider in its sole discretion. Prize Provider reserves the right to appoint a proxy to appear and participate in the Program for Finalist for any reason as it may determine in its sole discretion. The appointment of any proxy shall not affect Finalist's eligibility for the \$1 Million Prize.

NOTE: TERMS USED BUT NOT SPECIFICALLY DEFINED IN THESE TRIP PRIZE TERMS AND CONDITIONS [E.G., “FINALIST”, “TRIP PRIZE”, ETC.] MAY BE CHANGED TO BE CONSISTENT WITH THE PARTICIPATING LOTTERIES’ CUSTOMARY LANGUAGE USED IN ITS RULES/DISCLOSURES FOR THIS PROMOTION.

THE TERM “PARTICIPATING LOTTERY” OR “PARTICIPATING LOTTERIES” MEANS THOSE LOTTERIES THAT HAVE OFFERED THE NASCAR-POWERBALL THE CHASE PROMOTION.

THE TERM “PRIZE PROVIDER” IS THE MULTI-STATE LOTTERY ASSOCIATION (MUSL), OR, A THIRD-PARTY UNDER CONTRACT WITH MUSL TO FULFILL ALL ELEMENTS OF THE TRIP PRIZE EXCEPT THE SECOND PLACE CASH PRIZE OF

\$10,000, AND THE \$1 MILLION PRIZE.

EACH FINALIST IS ALLOWED (BUT NOT REQUIRED) TO SELECT ONE (1) GUEST TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TRIP PRIZE ONLY (NOT THE \$1 MILLION PRIZE).

DUE TO THE NATURE OF THE PROMOTION, FINALISTS’ NAMES WILL BE MADE PUBLIC.

The Trip Prize is valued at \$10,000.00.

Finalist and their guest (“Guest”) must travel on the same dates and times selected (on or about Friday November 6, 2026, and Monday, November 9, 2026), to participate in the Trip Prize. If Finalist and Guest are unable to or will not travel on the dates and times selected by the prize provider, the selected Finalist may choose a proxy on or before October 22, 2026. If no proxy is chosen by Finalist, Finalist will forfeit the Trip Prize (including attendance by Guest) but will still be entered into the drawing for and eligible to win the \$1 Million Prize and will be represented by a proxy provided by the appropriate Participating Lottery.

If Finalist resides fewer than two hundred fifty (250) miles from Miami, FL, Prize Provider, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to provide ground transportation for Finalist and Guest in lieu of airline transportation. If Finalist is under the age of twenty-one (21), Guest must be at least the age of majority in Guest’s state of residence. If Finalist is twenty-one (21) or older, Guest may be under the age of eighteen (18) but must be at least thirteen (13) years old (as of the first date of travel), and if Guest is a minor in Finalist’s state, Finalist must be the parent or legal guardian of Guest.

All other costs and expenses involved with or related to acceptance and/or participation in the Trip Prize not specifically included in the description of the Trip Prize, including, without limitation, ground transportation, transfers, additional hotel amenities (i.e., spa services, internet access, phone calls, laundry services), fees and gratuities, airline change fees, airline premium seat fees, and personal expenses such as laundry, valet service, photos, souvenirs, and other incidentals, are the sole responsibility of Finalist and Guest. Finalist will be required to submit a valid major credit card to the hotel to cover all expenses not

specifically awarded as part of the Trip Prize. Travel and hotel accommodation are subject to availability.

The date and location of any of the events or activities included in the Trip Prize (individually/collectively, “Event or Events”) may be subject to change. The Released Parties are not responsible if any Event associated with this Promotion is delayed, postponed, or cancelled for any reason, in whole or in part, and if any Event is delayed, postponed, or cancelled for any reason, in whole or in part, Prize Provider’s only obligation is to fulfill the other elements of the Trip Prize. No compensation will be paid in lieu of any cancelled Event or any other element of the Trip Prize.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, officers, directors, members, managers, agents, assigns, successors, employees, and contractors of Multi-State Lottery Association, Participating Lotteries, National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing, LLC, Homestead-Miami Speedway, LLC, and NASCAR Enterprises, LLC and each of their respective parent, subsidiary, shareholders, and/or affiliated entities ("Released Parties") and members of the immediate family (e.g., parents, spouse, children, siblings, grandparents, stepchildren, and stepsiblings and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) of any of the foregoing individuals are ineligible to participate in the POWERBALL's NASCAR The Chase™

promotion and/or win a Trip Prize and/or the \$1 Million Grand Prize.
